OUR MISSION:

To improve the quality of life for children and adults with disabilities through equine-assisted therapy.

OUR IMPACT:

Reins of Life is a PATH Intl. Premier Accredited Center offering equine-assisted services to children and adults with disabilities through therapeutic horseback riding, carriage driving, interactive vaulting, and a variety of unmounted programs. We are one of only ten centers in the country that utilize all three mounted disciplines (riding, driving, and vaulting) in addition to unmounted programs as supplemental interventions to traditional forms of therapy. Our diverse program offerings are a direct response to our community's needs.

OUR NEXT CHAPTER:

We have experienced a growing demand for our services. In 2023 alone, we received over 270 new inquiries from individuals in need of our programs. Despite our efforts to accommodate everyone, we maintained a waiting list of 15-25 individuals per session. We also had to limit the frequency and the number of school groups attending equine-assisted learning programs due to our limited space. The unprecedented growth requires us to expand and improve our South Bend facility so that we can better serve our community.

EXPANSION DETAILS

We are excited to share that we will be expanding and improving the South Bend facility to better meet the needs of our community. Our new facility will be fully ADA-compliant while retaining the ambiance and therapeutic impact of a farm environment. The expansion will include:

- A new indoor arena allowing us to offer more lessons, thus increasing the number of people served.
- A fire suppression system will ensure the safety of people and animals throughout the entire facility.
- The new **classroom** will provide a dedicated area to conduct activities with students, as well as improve the flow of students and groups through the facility.
- A renovated family viewing and play area creates a comfortable place for families and caretakers to watch their loved ones during their lessons, and for children to relax and play before their lesson.
- A sensory gym will provide a relaxing environment, which is essential for students with diagnoses of autism, ADHD, anxiety, and sensory processing
- **A new tack room** to house additional tack and equipment, associated with a higher volume of services.
- **Eight additional horse stalls** to expand our equine herd to meet the needs of expanded programs. The stall space also provides up-close learning and interaction opportunities for students.
- Two new therapy practice rooms will allow instructors and therapists/counselors to evaluate students, interview families, and provide therapy.
